AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO HARRISON COUNTY RURAL ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP

CORPORATION 89, (of Harrison County, Indiana) THE RIGHT, AND PERMISSION TO USE CERTAIN ALLEYS- AND/OR STREETS IN THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF AN ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER LINE TO ITS OWN PROPERTY,- AND BUILDING, IN SAID TOWN, FOR ITS USE EXCLUSIVELY AND NOT FOR DISTRIBUTION TO, OR FOR THE SERVICE TO OR FOR ANY ONE ELSE.

WHEREAS,- The Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation Number 89, (of Harrison County, Indiana) has asked the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana to grant to it, the said Corporation, the right and permission to construct into the said town of Corydon, Indiana along and over the streets and alleys of said town a line to be used to conduct and transmit to its property,- to its office and garage building- in said town, electric current, or currents, or electric energies, for use only by it in and on its own property: and

WHEREAS, The said Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation No. 89, is a non-profit service organization, serving the Agricultural *and* *other business* interests, of Harrison County, Indiana, in their homes: and

WHEREAS, The said Corporation requests the said privilege, and permission to so enter the corporate limits of said town of Corydon, Indiana, with its electric line for the sole and only purpose of conducting and transmitting electric current or currents, or electric energies, from its own electric line and current outside the town of Corydon, Indiana, to its own property,- office building and garage,- within said town of Corydon, and for its own use only to supply electric lights, electric power, electric current to and for its own buildings and property, and not to furnish or distribute such electric energies to any one else within the corporate limits of said town:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Harrison, County, Indiana:

That the said Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation Number 89, of Harrison County, Indiana, is hereby, by this ordinance, granted the right and privilege, and authority to establish, and construct into the corporate limits of said Town of Corydon, Indiana, an electric line, and to set and locate, by inserting same into the ground posts *and/or poles* as supports to hold and carry said electric line or lines, as hereinafter more specifically described, from the western boundary line of the corporate limits of said Town of Corydon, Indiana.

beginning at the west end of an alley, on the top of the east bank of Big Indian Creek, and following said alley eastward to Water Street, and on across said Water Street eastward, to the east side, or line of said Water Street, and thence on eastward across private property,- across lots in said Town of Corydon, Indiana now owned

by Willard Stoner and Sara J. Stoner, Dora E. Rosenbarger, The Nazarene Church and William Frederick and Laura Frederick all of whom have given said Corporation (R&M C) Easements for use of their property

to the property, in said Town of Corydon, Harrison County, Indiana, owned by the said Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation No. 89, of Harrison County, Indiana, to-wit:

Seventy-two (72) feet in width off the west side of Lot Number sixty-nine (69) in the town of Corydon, Harrison County, Indiana, being seventy-two (72) feet front on the south side of Chestnut Street in said town and extending the full length (165 feet) of said lot.

Also a part of Lot Number Eighty-one (81) in the town of Corydon, Harrison County, Indiana, bounded as follows: Beginning at the north east corner of said lot, running thence south eighty (80) feet to thence west sixteen (16) feet, thence north eighty (80) feet to the north line of said lot, thence east along the north line of said lot sixteen (16) feet to the place of beginning.

Also a part of Lot Number Eighty-two (82) in the town of Corydon, Harrison County, Indiana, bounded as follows; Beginning at the northwest corner of said lot, running thence south along the west line of said lot eighty (80) feet, thence east fifty-six (56) feet, thence north eighty (80) feet to the north line of said lot, thence west along the north line of said lot fifty-six (56) feet to the place of beginning,- containing 4480 square feet in this last described lot.

Said electric line,- including the posts, or poles,- to support and carry, or maintain same are to be located, and are to be as follows:

They are to be located and set and used and maintained by said Corporation, said Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation No. 89, on said street and alley subject to all the obligations, rights and privileges of the Public Service Company of Indiana, holding a franchise for the distribution of electric energy in the town of Corydon, Indiana, and subject also to all personal and private property rights of the property owners abutting said street and alley, and also so as to least interfere with the use of said alley and street by the public in their use of same.

It is also further ordained, ordered and provided that the said Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation, of Harrison County, Indiana, shall have, and it is hereby by this ordinance, given the right and permission to trim any trees growing on or along said alley and/or street to enable it to construct and maintain, and keep in repair such electric line, or lines, and the posts, or poles carrying and supporting same.

Construct said electric line.

It is understood that the said alley to be thus used by said Corporation,- the said Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation No. 89, is as follows: Running east and west through the Ginkins and Shaffer Subdivision of lots numbered Seventy-two to Seventy-nine in the Town of Corydon, Harrison County, Indiana, from the west side, or line of Water Street west to the west line of the said Town of Corydon, Indiana, and being parallel with and between the west ends of Chestnut and Poplar Streets in said town of Corydon.

It is also ordered and provided as a part of this ordinance, that the said Harrison County Rural Electric Membership Corporation, No. 89, of Harrison County, Indiana, is to secure from all property owners over whose premises it constructs said electric line easements, in writing, from such property owners granting such use of their property.

X The above and foregoing ordinance, and each part thereof, passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, ^{the first time} on the 28th. day of July, 1941, by the following vote,

meeting, at their office in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, on the 25th day of August, 1941, at 7-30 o'clock ^{daylight saving time} P.M., and the Clerk-Treasurer

of said Town of Corydon, Indiana, is now ordered to publish a notice of such final hearing, in the two County papers,- The Corydon Democrat and The Corydon

Republican, both published in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, in ^{one} successive issues of said newspapers, the first publications thereof to be fully ^{fifteen days} before, or prior to, said date of such final hearing.
