An Ordinance Changing the Name of Market Street
in the town of Corydon, Indiana, to
Capitol Avenue

Section 1. BE IT ORDAINED that the name of the street known and designated on the original plat of the town of Corydon, Indiana, as Market Street, be changed and that the name of said street be changed from Market Street to Capitol Avenue.

Section 2. That a certified copy of this Ordinance changing the name of Market Street to Capitol Avenue in said town be recorded in the Recorder's Office of Harrison County, Indiana.

Section 3. WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this Ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

The above and foregoing Ordinance and each Section and part thereof, passed, adopted and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the town of Corydon, Indiana, on this the 25th day of August, 1941.
