ORDINANCE NO. 1956-9

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE IN THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA

WHEREAS: The present rates being charged for the sewer service in the Town of Corydon, Indiana are insufficient to pay the costs of operation of the sewage treatment works, provide funds for renewal and replacement of the worn out plant, and provide sufficient funds for the sewage sinking fund of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, out of which the sewer works revenue bonds are paid; and

WHEREAS: This matter was considered at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana had and held at the regular meeting, place at the regular time on August 27th, 1956, and

WHEREAS: At said meeting said board considered that it would be necessary to increase said rates effective September 1, 1956, in order to provide sufficient funds to retire the sewer revenue bonds which will be due and payable on January 1, 1957; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana determined that the schedule of rates which would be necessary to be effective September 1, 1956 in order that sufficient funds for the aforesaid purposes will be timely provided, would be as follows:

Gallons of Water	Rate Per Thousand
First 2,000	30¢
Second 3,000	20¢
next 5,000	16¢
Next 10,000	14¢
Next 20,000	12¢
Next All over 40,000	10¢
Minimum (up to 4,000)	\$1.00

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Section 2 of Chapter 299 of the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana of 1945, notice of said proposed increase was published and concurrently notice of a proposed hearing on said proposed increased was published in the weekly newspapers of general circulation printed and published in the English language at Corydon, Indiana, which said notices are more fully set forth in proofs of publication thereof, attached to this ordinance, made a part hereof and marked "Exhibit A & B".

WHEREAS: Said hearing was held according to the published notices thereof, and not one person appeared thereat to object or remonstrate.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. Effective September 1, 1956, the rates for sewer service in the Town of Corydon, Indiana shall be as follows:

Gallons	Rate Per Thousand
First 2,000	30¢
Next 3,000	20¢
Next 5,000	16¢
Next 10,000	14¢
Next 20,000	12¢
All over 40,000	10¢
Minimum - Up to 4,000	\$1.00

Section 2. That all other provisions of said sewer ordinance presently in effect in the Town of Corydon, Indiana shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

THE ABOVE AND FOREGOING ORDINANCE and each section and part thereof was passed, adopted, and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at a regular meeting of said Board ^{held} and held on the 24th day of September, 1956, at the regular meeting place of said Board in the Town of Corydon, Indiana.
