

"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AUTOMOBILE PARKING IN THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA, ON THE EAST SIDE OF CAPITAL AVENUE, BETWEEN HIGH STREET AND THE CORPORATION LIMITS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TOWN TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION 1. To regulate and promote the handling of automobile traffic over and upon the Streets of Corydon, it is hereby decreed that the parking of motor vehicles of any kind shall be and the same is hereby prohibited on the east side of Capitol Avenue between High Street north to the Corporation limits of the Town of Corydon, Indiana.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not more than \$10.00.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

THE ABOVE AND FOREGOING ORDINANCE, and each section and part thereof was passed, adopted, and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at a regular meeting of said Board had and held on the 12th day of August, 1957 at the regular meeting place of said Board in the Town of Corydon, Indiana.
