ORDINANCE NO. 1970-SEW-2

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1963-SEW-2 fixing the schedule of rates and charges to be collected by the Town of Corydon, Indiana, from the owners of property served by the sewage works of said Town, and other matters connected therewith

WHEREAS, the Town of Corydon has heretofore constructed and has in operation sewage works for the purpose of collecting and disposing in a sanitary manner of sewage of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town has authorized the issuance of additional revenue bonds to provide funds, together with a federal grant and a state grant, to pay the cost of improvements and extensions to such sewage works; and

WHEREAS, the revenues from the existing sewage treatment rates and charges established by Ordinance No. 1963-SEW-2, adopted on May 13, 1963, are insufficient to pay principal and interest on the additional revenue bonds, and the Board of Trustees now finds that the rates and charges established by said ordinance should be increased; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1963-SEW-2, adopted on May 13, 1963, be amended to read as follows: Section 1. For the use of and the service rendered by said sewage works, rates and charges shall be collected for the use of and the service rendered by said sewage works from the owners of each and every lot, parcel of real estate or building that is connected with or uses such works, by or through

any part of the sewerage system of the Town of Corydon, or that in any way uses or is served by such works, which rates and charges shall be payable as hereinafter provided and shall be in an amount determinable as follows:

A. The sewage rates and charges shall be based on the quantity of water used on or in the property or premises subject to such rates and charges, as the same is measured by the water meter there in use, except as herein otherwise provided.

B. The water usage on which the amount of said sewage rates and charges shall be determined and the amount of said sewage rates and charges shall be as follows:

<u>Consumption Per Month</u>	<u>Charge Per 1,000 Gallons</u>
First 3,000 gallons	\$2.48
Next 7,000 gallons	2.17
Next 10,000 gallons	1.86
Next 20,000 gallons	1.55
Next 60,000 gallons	1.24
Next 100,000 gallons	.93
All over 200,000 gallons	.47

The minimum charge for any user shall be not less than \$7.44 per month.

C. The charge for any service where the user is not a metered water consumer shall be based on the size of sewage service connection determined by means and methods satisfactory to the Town of Corydon, but in no event shall such charge be less than the minimum charge hereinbefore set forth.

D. For the services rendered to the Town of Corydon, said Town shall be subject to the same rates and charges as hereinbefore provided or to charges and rates established in harmony therewith.

Sec. 2. That the remaining sections of said Ordinance No. 1963-SEW-2 remain in full force and effect and shall not be deemed to have been amended or altered in any respect by this ordinance.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
