ORDINANCE NO. 1975-SEW-1

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1970-SEW-2 fixing the schedule of rates and charges to be collected by the Town of Corydon, Indiana, from the owners of property served by the sewage works of said Town, and other matters connected therewith

WHEREAS, the Town of Corydon has heretofore constructed and has in operation sewage works for the purpose of collecting and disposing in a sanitary manner of sewage of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees find that the rates and charges being assessed by Ordinance 1970-SEW-2 provide more than sufficient revenue to pay principle and interest on existing revenue bonds, and collect expenses for maintenance and operation of the sewage works of said Town, the sewage rates and charges should be reduced, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA:

Section L. That Section 1B. of Ordinance No. 1970-SEW-2, adopted on September 9, 1970, be amended to read as follows:

Section 1B. The water usage on which the amount of said sewage rates and charges shall be determined and the amount of said sewage rates and charges shall be as follows:

<u>Consumption Per Month</u>	<u>Charge Per 1,000 Gallons</u>
First 3,000 Gallons	\$2.11
Next 7,000 Gallons	\$1.84
Next 10,000 Gallons	\$1.58
Next 20,000 Gallons	\$1.32
Next 60,000 Gallons	\$1.05
Next 100,000 Gallons	\$.79
Over 200,000 Gallons	\$.40

The minimum charge for any amount shall not be any less than \$6.33 per month.

Section 2. That the remaining sections of said Ordinance 1970-SEW-2 remain in full force and effect and shall not be deemed to be amended or altered in any respect by this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as provided by law.
