Everyone stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Judy Kennedy made a motion to approve the minutes from March 4, 2019. Jill Timberlake seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

The Board then held a discussion on the current zoning map. The changes on the printed map to bring it current had been made with the exception of one property. That map will be finished within the week. The Board felt that if there was a zoning error found in the future that the error could be rectified easily, and without cost to the owner. With the information they currently have, however, they felt that at this time the current map is a good presentation of the overall zoning in Corydon. Chris Byrd stated that while the Board did not need a public meeting to officially adopt the map, it would be a good idea for the sake of transparency. The Board agreed and set a public meeting for anyone who would like to see and/or discuss the map on May 6 at 7:00 PM, a half hour before the regular Planning and Zoning Meeting.
