Everyone stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Barbara Scharrer made a motion to approve the April 6, 2021 Meeting Minutes with the change that the minutes reflect the color of the chimney-type structure would match the current chimney. Janet Bischoff seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0. Janet Bischoff made a motion to approve the March 16, 2021 Meeting Minutes. Barbara Scharrer seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0

Tim Johnson requested a COA for to replace the shingles on the house and create a higher pitch on the flat roof section between his house and his garage and replace the current metal roofing in that area with shingles. Tim also stated that he would be replacing his gutters and repairing the chimney. The Commission discussed the fact that the drainage issue would be helped by the change in roofline. The shingles would match the shingles on the house, the gutters, while a change from the current box gutters, would not be visible from the street. The chimney repair would not change the look of the chimney. The commission felt the changes were within the guidelines. Barbara made the motion to approve the COA. Janet seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

Laura spoke to the commission about sending postcards to residents in the Historic District. She said she would make the postcards if Susan Mills would stamp and them. Janet stated that she would be willing to help Susan with the mailing. The Commission agreed to have Laura make the informational post cards and have Susan send them.
