

**TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA  
ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 5**

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEYS IN THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Statutes the Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana is responsible for decisions in determining the vacating of public roads and alleys within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Corydon; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana has been presented a petition by HBU Properties, LLP requesting to close alleys more particularly described as follows:

An alley located within the Hill Crest Subdivision or Addition that lies between Lots 16, 17, 18 and 19 of the Subdivision and an alley which is on the southerly side of Lots 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the Subdivision.

WHEREAS, the Town of Corydon, Indiana has caused to be published a notice of hearing to be held on the petition for the closing of such alleys;

WHEREAS, the date for the hearing having arrived at a meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana on October 4, 2022, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council having considered such petition,


NOW THEREFORE, IT BE ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA that the alleys so described above are hereby vacated by the Town of Corydon, Indiana.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the vacation of that portion of the public alleys described hereinabove are subject to the right of Town of Corydon to maintain, repair or replace any existing utilities, including natural or man-made drainage facilities and that the vacation shall not affect governmental rights to those areas designated as flood ways, flood plains and/or flood ponding areas.

This Ordinance shall be furnished to the Harrison County Recorder for the purposes of recording and a copy maintained by the Harrison County Auditor.






