

Council Minutes of Special Called Meeting

December 31, 2022

A special called meeting of the Corydon Town Council met on Saturday, December 31, 2022, to discuss Ordinance 2022-08 which had been adopted, allowing the Council to redistrict the five wards within Corydon. Harlan Fisher, Hope Schneider, Paul Hamann, and Council President Les Rhoads attended the meeting. Doug Castetter was absent, and the Clerk-Treasurer was absent from the meeting.

The meeting was called to order by President Rhoads. The Pledge of Allegiance led by Harlan Fisher.

The meeting was called to discuss the census block issue regarding the area North of Franklin Street and East of Finn Street (but still within the town limits- #180610604012025, also the northern half of the green bottom image) which was displayed on a map during the meeting. These streets were originally in Ward 4, but they were moved to Ward 5 so the entire block would be in one ward. The updated map now shows Ward 4 with the census blocks from the Census website.

The other discrepancy had the area east of Woodlawn Av, west of Indian Creek, and North of 62 in the town limits, and they are not. The area north of Franklin Street is in the same census block south of Floyd Street and east of Pflanz Drive but are split into different wards.

Harlan Fisher made a motion to adopt **ORDINANCE NO. 2022-09 TO REDISTRIC TOWN COUNCIL DISTRICT (WARDS)** with the corrected changes and Paul Hamann seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.

There being no further business to come before the Council and with a motion from Harlan Fisher, seconded by Paul Hamann, the meeting adjourned.
