

Corydon Town Council
Meeting Minutes
May 5, 2020

The Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, met in the Town Hall, 219 North Capitol Av, Corydon, Indiana on the 5th day of May 2020 at the hour of 7:30 p.m. Due to the COVID- 19 virus and the Executive Order from Governor of Indiana restricting public meetings to 10 people, the Town of Corydon conducted the meeting with 8 people present and live streaming of the meeting for the public.

The meeting was called to order by Lester Rhoads who presided and the pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Rand Heazlitt.

On call of the roll, the members of the Council were shown to be present or absent as follows:

Clerk- Treasurer Treggie King, and Town Manager Rand Heazlitt also attended the meeting.

Doug Castetter made a motion to approve minutes of the previous meeting and Hope Schneider seconded the motion with an approval vote of 5-0.

Paul Hamann made the motion to approve claims and sign bills. Hope Schneider seconded the motion and it carried 5-0.

Planning & Zoning

It was noted that Planning and Zoning extended their review of the icehouse to determine the business classification of the site.

Cedar Hill Cemetery, at the request of Jim Smith, requested a thirteen-year-old zero turn lawn mower with two thousand hours be scrapped by taking it to the recycling center on Quarry Rd. Tyson Uhl made a motion to approve the request and Hope Schneider seconded the motion which carried 5-0.

Tyson Uhl made the motion to approve Peyton Technical Services quote of \$1600 for installed security cameras. Paul Hamann seconded the motion and it carried 5-0.

Tyson Uhl made the motion to approve the purchase of a spare pump for \$7,120 as an emergency backup unit. Rand Heazlitt agreed with the recommendation and stated the pump warranty begins when the pump is installed instead of the purchase date. Paul Hamann seconded the motion and it carried 5-0.

Jill Saegesser announced the Lt. Governor awarded the Town of Corydon a \$250K grant to have quick impact for Corydon small businesses as a result from the COVID business closures. Ms. Saegesser provided information and answered questions regarding the grant application and the requirements for business eligibility. She requested the Council authorize Lester Rhoads and Treggie King as signatories for the Grant Agreement between the Town of Corydon and the State of Indiana after the grant is reviewed by Chris Byrd. The Town is required to schedule a public hearing and approve a Review

Committee Board. The Council discussed appointing Hope Schneider, Tyson Uhl, Treggie King, Jill Saegesser and Tony Myers to the Review Board and to set May 26th at 3pm for the public hearing. Paul Hamann made the motions to approve authorizing Treggie King and Lester Rhoads to sign the agreement with the State, to approve the committee appointees, and approve the public hearing date. Hope Schneider seconded the motions and they carried with a 5-0 vote.

Tyson Uhl reminded the Council that he has family with businesses in Town as it would pertain to the grant and Vice-President Paul Hamann advised him to recuse himself from those decisions and Tyson Uhl agreed to do so.

Ms. Saegesser provided a list of required information that will be used as qualifiers for the businesses grant application. She emphasized this information should be marketed by the Town and stipulated the grant eligibility is for profit businesses only. The targeted date for having all necessary application documents, forms, policy, etc. is May 18th. The public hearing will be publicized in The Corydon Democrat on May 13, 2020. The applications from businesses will be submitted via mail or hand carried to the Clerk/Treasurer. As the information is received by the Clerk-Treasurer, it will be signed by her and have a date stamp and time to each request. OCRA will require a public hearing which will be scheduled for the June 2, 2020 meeting.

Tyson Uhl made a motion to approve bond 32S437132 with annual dates of May 27, 2020 to May 27, 2021 for Pam Byrne. Doug Castetter seconded the motion. It carried 5-0.

Tyson Uhl made the motion to approve Hope Schneider to the Planning and Zoning board and Paul Hamann seconded with the motion carrying 5-0.

President Rhoads informed the board that the new touch Screen had been instated at the WWTP.

There being no further business to come before the Council and upon a motion made by Paul Hamann and seconded by Hope Schneider, the meeting adjourned.
