

AN ORDINANCE LICENSING TRAVELING PEDDLERS, TRANSIENT SALESMEN, AND ITINERANT VENDORS OF GOODS, WARES, AND MERCHANCISE, FIXING THE LICENSE FEE THEREFORE, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, as follows:--

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, company or corporation to engage in the business of traveling peddler, transient salesman or itinerant vendor of goods, wares and or merchandise within the corporate limits of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, without first procuring a license so to do, providing always that the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to residents of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, engaging in the business of retailing merchandise within the town of Corydon, Indiana.

Section 2. That any person, persons, firm, company or corporation desiring to obtain a license to engage in the business of traveling peddler, transient salesman or itinerant vendor of goods, wares and or merchandise shall make application to the Town Clerk for license so to do and shall pay the Town Clerk, the following license fees, to-wit:

For one day: \$5.00 (Five Dollars) For one year: \$ 50.00 (Fifty Dollars)

for each truck or vehicle and upon the payment of the said license fee, the Town Clerk shall issue to said applicant a license for the period for which said license fee is paid.

Section 3. That peddlers of Dairy products shall abide by section 1 and 2, of this ordinance, except the license fee for any person engaged in the peddling of dairy products shall be, to-wit:--

For one day: \$2.50 (Two dollars and Fifty cents)
For one year \$25.00 (Twenty-five dollars)

for each truck or vehicle and in addition a health permit must be on file with the Clerk-treasurer of said Town.

Section 4. That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit and pay to the Town of Corydon, Indiana, the sum of Ten Dollars for each day of the violation of the same.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. That whereas an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

The above and foregoing ordinance and each section and part thereof, passed, adopted, and approved, by the Board of Town Trustees, of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at the regular meeting of the Board of Town Trustees, had and held at its regular meeting place in said Town on the 28th day of December, 1959.
