

ORDINANCE NO. 1970-P-1

An Ordinance Creating a Crime Control Fund
for
the Town of Corydon, Indiana

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA:

Section 1. Title. The title of this fund shall be Crime Control Fund.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this fund shall be for the purchase of special and necessary police equipment to increase the efficiency, effectiveness and safety of all employees of the Town of Corydon's police department.

Section 3. Funding. The Town of Corydon shall allocate and appropriate adequate funds in the annual budget to provide for the expenditures from this fund and further that the Town of Corydon shall apply for funds to be used for the purposes of this fund under the Federal Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (Public Law 90-351). Further that the Town of Corydon will abide with all Federal requirements under the said Public Law 90-351.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption as provided by law.

The above and foregoing ordinance and each section and part was passed, adopted, and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at a regular meeting of said Board had and held on the 10 day of August, 1970.
