ORDINANCE NO.: 1974 - LIQUOR RETAILERS PERMIT - 1

AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING THAT LIQUOR RETAILERS PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED TO PREMISES WITHIN THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the consent of said Town be and the same is hereby given and granted unto the proper legal authorities of the State of Indiana, to issue Liquor Retailers Permits for the sale of alcoholic, spiritous beverages to applicants otherwise duly qualified to premises within said Town, all agreeable to the provisions of Section 18 of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, entitled "AN ACT- concerning alcoholic beverages, liquids and substances, and to promote temperance, repealing laws and parts of laws and declaring an emergency," approved March 11, 1935.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given affect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and affect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
