ORDINANCE NO. 2010-TRAF-1-AMEND

AN AMENDMENT TO AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED
LIMITS IN THE TOWN OF CORYDON.

WHEREAS, the Town Council is the legislative governing body of the Town of Corydon in the State of Indiana, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with I.C. 36-1-3-6, a municipality may adopt an ordinance prescribing a specific manner for exercising a power, and







WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Corydon, Indiana adopted a speed limit ordinance in 2010 that did not specify to which account all fines and penalties for such violations of the speed limit ordinance are to be deposited, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Corydon, Indiana has determined that any collection of fines and penalties under the speed limit ordinance shall be deposited into the General Fund of the Town of Corydon, Indiana pursuant to I.C. 9-21-1-2(c);

BE IT NOW THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Corydon Town Council, pursuant to I.C. 36-1-3-6 that the collection of any fines and penalties under the speed limit ordinance (Ordinance No. 2010-TRAF-1) shall be placed into the General Fund of the Town of Corydon, Indiana.

The herein Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and its publication as provided by law.
