ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 02

ORDINANCE TO AMEND TOWN OF CORYDON
ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1955

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, (the "Town") desire to amend the existing Town Zoning Ordinance in regard to the number of parking spaces required of retail businesses;

WHEREAS, the Town believes that such amendment to the Town's Zoning Ordinance will best balance the economic development and traffic needs of the citizens and visitors of the Town of Corydon;

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend the Zoning Ordinance to amend the number of retail parking spaces required under its zoning laws;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA that the existing Town Zoning Ordinance and as later amended be further amended as follows:

Section VI.e. shall now read as follows:

Stores and other establishments in local business districts: one parking space for each 230 square feet of store floor area.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana and the requisite publication of two consecutive weeks in the local county newspaper.
