ORDINANCE NO. 2-1966

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN ONE-WAY STREETS IN THE BUSINESS AREA TO IMPROVE THE TRAFFIC FLOW AND PARKING CONGESTION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, that due to the congestion of motor vehicular traffic in the business area of said Town, the following streets shall have two-way traffic removed and one-way traffic shall be established as follows:

1. Elm Street shall be designated for one-way traffic travelling north from Chestnut Street to Walnut Street.
2. A part of Beaver Street shall be designated for one-way traffic travelling east from Capitol Avenue to Elm Street.
3. A part of Beaver Street shall be designated for one-way traffic travelling west from Capitol Avenue to Oak Street.
4. Cherry Street shall be designated for one-way traffic travelling west from Capitol Avenue to Oak Street.
5. Oak Street shall be designated for one-way traffic travelling south from Walnut Street to Chestnut Street.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
