ORDINANCE NO: 1974-SEW-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO: 1963-  
SEW-3 BY PROVIDING FOR CONNECTION FEES FOR  
NEW SEWER SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON,  
INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section four (4) of Ordinance No: 1963-  
SEW-3 is hereby amended by the addition of a new subsection to be  
referred to as Subsection (o) of Section four (4), of Ordinance  
No: 1963-SEW-3 as follows:

(o). Connection Fees for New Sewer Services. The following  
charges shall be assessed for all new sewer connections. These  
charges shall be in addition to existing permit and inspection fees.

1. The connection fees charged for sewer service to all new customers shall be:
  - a. For multi-unit housing developments such as apartments or trailer parks, excluding subdivisions which shall be charged according to Sub-section (c) hereof, served by the same service line, the fee shall be One Hundred Twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars per unit.
  - b. For motels, the fee shall be Sixty-two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$62.50) per unit.
  - c. For all other residential, commercial, or industrial customers, including sub-division developments, the fee shall be based on the size of water meter serving the customer as follows:

<u>METER SIZE</u>	<u>CONNECTION FEE</u>
5/8-3/4 inch meter	\$ 250.00
1 inch meter	750.00
1 1/2 inch meter	1,500.00
2 inch meter	3,000.00
3 inch meter	6,000.00
4 inch meter	10,000.00
6 inch meter	18,000.00

2. Additional fees to be charged in areas where Town owned sewer lines, built at the Town's expense, are located adjacent to the customer's property, are as follows:
  - a. The fee in addition to that under Subsection (o) (1) above, shall be Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each foot of front footage included in the customer's lot. Front footage shall be defined as the length of the property line facing the front of the structure on the customer's property.
3. Method of Payment. The connection fees provided for under Section 4, Subsection (o), shall be paid in full to the Town Clerk prior to actual connection of the service to the town sewer system.
4. There shall be a grace period for town residents, to be determined by the corporate limits of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, as of September 1, 1973, of one year in which town residents shall be permitted to connect onto the sewer system and this schedule of connection fees shall not apply.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
