

Ordinance No. 1999-SEW-1

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES

BE ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. ORDINANCE NO. 1976-SEW-1, the previous ordinance establishing sewer connection charges, is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. Every prospective customer of the sewage works of the Town of Corydon shall obtain a building sewer permit from the Town prior to use of any structure required to be connected to the said works. Application therefore shall be made on forms prescribed and provided by the Town and shall be supplemented by such plans, specifications and other information as may be determined by the Inspector to be necessary. Upon approval of the application by the Inspector, the applicant shall pay a connection fee in the amount of \$1,025.00 and an inspection fee in the amount of \$50.00. As consideration for the said connection fee, the Town will provide a line from the sewer main to the property line of the applicant, provided, that if the sewer main is more then 30 feet from the point where the line from the main intersects the property line of the property of the applicant, an additional charge based on total actual additional cost will be made to pay for the additional line, provided, further, that the aforesaid connection fee is based primarily on connecting a six inch line with an eight inch main and in the event a larger size line or a larger main is involved, an additional charge based on total actual additional cost will be made to cover the additional total actual cost to the Town for making such connection.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective on the date of adoption.
