"An Ordinance Regulating the use of outdoor toilets in the Town of Corydon, Indiana; and prohibiting their use and making mandatory the installation and use of indoor flush-type sanitary toilet facilities wherever possible, and providing penalties for the violation thereof."

WHEREAS, There has been in the town of Corydon, Indiana for many years, a sanitary sewer system, and

WHEREAS, At the inception of said sewer system there was an ordinance enacted requiring the abandonment when unusable of outdoor toilets and the installation in the dwelling on said premises of indoor sanitary flush type toilet facilities for use in connection with said sewer system, and prohibiting the construction of any additional outdoor toilets in the Town of Corydon, Indiana at any residence where sewer facilities were available, and

WHEREAS, Owing to the national emergency existing between 1940 and 1946, the provisions of this ordinance were not enforced because of the shortage of materials with which to install indoor and sanitary flush-type toilet facilities, and

WHEREAS, The Town of Corydon has caused an investigation to be made by the proper department of the State Board of Health as to the condition of the outdoor toilets now existing in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, Such report discloses that there are no outdoor toilets located on premises in the Town of Corydon, where sewer facilities are available which comply with the regulations of the State Board of Health, or of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, said said State Board of Health has condemned all such toilets and the use thereof as being injurious to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Corydon, Indiana, and

WHEREAS; There are now abundant materials for the installation of indoor sanitary flush-type toilet facilities for use in connection with the sewer system in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, and

WHEREAS; the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Corydon, Indiana, require that outdoor toilets be abandoned and discontinued except in every case where the sewer facilities in the Town of Corydon, Indiana are not available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA; That:--

Section 1. It shall be unlawful on and after the 15th day of August, 1955, to use or permit to be used any outdoor toilet on any premises in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, to and for which sewer facilities are available.

Section 2. It shall be mandatory on and after the 15th day of August, 1955 that the owner of every residence/^{or building} on any premises for which sewer facilities are available in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, to install in said dwelling, indoor sanitary flush-type toilet facilities, for use in, and connected with the sewer system in said town.

Section 3. Any person who violates either Sections 1 or Sections 2 of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$10.00. Each day of violation of Sections 1 or 2, of this Ordinance shall constitute a distinct and separate offense.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.

THE ABOVE AND FOREGOING ORDINANCE and each section and part thereof was passed, adopted and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at a regular meeting of said Board had and held on the 27th day of September, 1954, at the regular meeting place of Said Board in the Town of Corydon, Indiana.
