

ORDINANCE 2019 - 02

TOWN OF CORYDON

**AN ORDINANCE INSTALLING NEW STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION
OF MAPLE & WALNUT STREETS IN CORYDON, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Town Council of the Town of Corydon, Indiana ("Town Council") to protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that certain traffic control devices are necessary at the intersection of Maple and Walnut Streets within the town limits and that a 4 way stop sign is the most appropriate means of traffic control; and

WHEREAS, residents in the area of the proposed new stop signs have expressed their desire to the Town Council for such traffic control in an effort to enhance public safety of residents in the area of the intersection; and

WHEREAS, after the consideration of the public's request and observance of the traffic in the area, the Town Council has determined that stop signs should be erected as a 4-way stop at the intersection of Maple Street and Walnut Street in Corydon, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL of the Town of Corydon, Indiana that stop signs shall be installed controlling traffic traveling north and south on Maple Street and east and west on Walnut Street and that such stop signs shall be a 4-way stop at the intersection of said roadways.





IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED by the Town Council that one that violates this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties set forth for moving violations under Indiana Code and that any violation shall be reported to the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles for the assessment of points and other penalties that may be applicable pursuant to state law.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication. Its enforcement may occur after the stop sign referred to above is erected.
