AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS IN TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA, FIXING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, That:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful at any time to park on the east side of North Oak Street, between West Chestnut Street and West Walnut Street, unless otherwise specified.

SECTION II It shall be unlawful to park on South Side of Cherry Street, between Capitol Avenue and North Oak Street at any time unless otherwise specified.

SECTION III. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions in this ordinance, and found guilty, shall be fined in any sum not less than fifty-cents (\$0.50) nor more than ten (10.00) dollars.

SECTION IV Whereas, an emergency exist, for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance the same shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage.

The above and foregoing ORDINANCE and each section and part thereof passed and adopted and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at the regular meeting of said Board the 25th day of February 1952.
