ORDINANCE No. 1955 - 2

"An Ordinance Regulating Automobile Parking in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, On Mulberry Street Between Chestnut Street and Poplar Street and Declaring an Emergency."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TOWN TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CORYDON, INDIANA, THAT:-

SECTION 1. To regulate and promote the handling of automobile traffic over and upon the streets of Corydon, it is hereby decreed that there shall be parallel parking only on the <sup>east and</sup> west side of Mulberry Street between Chestnut Street and Poplar Street in the Town of Corydon, Indiana.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$10.00.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

THE ABOVE AND FOREGOING ORDINANCE and each section and part thereof was passed, adopted, and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at a regular meeting of said Board had and held on the 27 day of June, 1955, at the regular meeting place of said Board in the Town of Corydon, Indiana.
