

An ordinance for the establishment of Parallel parking on Mulberry Street between Chestnut Street and Walnut Street, in the town of Corydon, Indiana.

Whereas: Diagonal Parking on Mulberry Street between Chestnut Street and Mulberry Street is creating a traffic hazard at such place;

Whereas: It is the responsibility of the Board of Town Trustees to provide for the regulation and control the traffic on the streets of the town, to provide for the safety of the users of said streets and the inhabitants of the town.

Now Therefore: be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana.

Section 1: On and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be parked in a diagonal position on the street of Mulberry between Chestnut Street and Walnut Street.

Section 2: On and after the passage of this ordinance parallel parking only shall be lawful on Mulberry Street between Chestnut Street and Walnut Street in the Town of Corydon Indiana.

Section 3 : Whereas, and emergency exist for the immediate effect of this ordinance the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

THE ABOVE AND FOREGOING ORDINANCE AND EACH SECTION and part thereof was passed, adopted, and approved by the Board of Town Trustees of the Town of Corydon, Indiana, at a regular meeting of said Board had and held on the 10th day of August 1953 at the regular meeting place of said Board in the Town of Corydon, Indiana.
