When asked about the timeline to RFP, Jill said she would like to see them get something out	to
developers by September.	

Paul Hamman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Les Rhoads seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0. The meeting was adjourned at 9:13 PM.
