The Board of Town Trustees met in regular Session in their regular meeting place, the Town Hall, with the following named Trustees present and forming a quorum, namely:

Robert Rothrock, Arthur Weathers, Darrell Faith, Earl Beckort, and Carl Saulman.

Robert Rothrock, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. and presided thereat.

The Board discussed the progress payments authorized by the Engineers in favor of the Mather Construction Company, Inc. for work on the Industrial Park Sewer project and the Sewer Plant project; and on motion by Mr. Faith, seconded by Mr. Saulman, and unanimously passed, the Clerk was authorized to pay the progress payment of \$77,371.75 for the Sewer Plant project and the progress payment of \$2,034.00 for the Industrial Park Sewer project.

The Chairman read a proposal for a water survey from Clyde Williams & Associates, Inc.; and after discussion, on motion by Mr. Saulman, seconded by Mr. Beckort, and unanimously passed, the Chairman was authorized to enter into a contract with said firm, at a cost not to exceed \$5,000, to make a survey of the entire water system, as to present source of supply, treatment facilities, distribution system, and storage.

The Board next discussed the tentative town budget and authorized publication of the tentative budget with notice of the consideration of the budget at the August 23rd meeting.

Mr. Joseph Feller and Norman Troncin appeared before the Board inquiring as to the status of the report on the Hospital Hill Drainage problem. The town attorney read a report from the town engineers offering two alternatives, and reported that the engineers were preparing plans to be offered to the Town for settlement of the problem.

Mr. Robert Harris and Hugh Becker presented the necessary affidavit to the Town Clerk on the behalf of the Citizens Party, in order that that party could appear on the town election ballot in November. They also presented a list of five demands on behalf of the Concerned Citizens Committee, which said list was taken under advisement by the Board.

Mr. Edgar Yates appeared before the Board requesting action on the crossing on East Chestnut Street, near the Junior High School; the town attorney was requested by the Board to again contact the State Highway Commission and seek information as to the cost of the recommended traffic signals.

Claims were read and, upon motion, warrants were ordered drawn upon the Treasury in payment of the same as follows.
