WHEREAS, after full and open discussion of the present water needs of this community, said discussion being had at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board Of Trustees of the Town Of Corydon, Indiana, and,

WHEREAS, it is the feeling of the majority of the Board Of Trustees of the Town Of Corydon, Indiana, that participation in the Indian Creek Conservancy District is not in the best interest of the Town Of Corydon, Indiana, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Of Corydon, Indiana, does hereby withdraw from participation in and support of the Indian Creek Conservancy District program.
