RESOLUTION NO. 7

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLERK-TREASURER TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED IN THE COMMENCEMENT OF A LAWSUIT TO ENFORCE ORDINANCE NO. 1963 - SEW - 3

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Corydon that certain Federal and State funds are being withheld from the Town of Corydon, such funds to be disbursed in satisfaction of indebtedness incurred in the expansion of the municipal Sewage Treatment Plant, and

WHEREAS, the cause of the withholding of such funds is based upon investigations and reports of the Indiana State Board of Health as to violations of portions of Ordinance No. 1963-SEW-3 by ARPAC, Inc., a commercial user of the municipal sewer system, and

WHEREAS, funds will not be released until such time as the Town of Corydon enforces the provisions of said Ordinance No. 1963 - SEW - 3,

BE IT NOW RESOLVED:

That the town of Corydon, Indiana, take such measures and procedures necessary for the enforcement of said Ordinance No. 1963 - SEW - 3 , including the institution of legal proceedings, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Corydon Indiana be authorized to sign and execute all papers, documents and pleadings necessary to accomplish the enforcement of such Ordinance.
