RESOLUTION 2--1952

Be it resolved by the Town Board of the Town of Corydon Indiana.

That the Parking Meters be removed from the Street of Corydon, Indiana at the following location: fifty (50) feet on the North side of lot #64 in the Town of Corydon, Indiana, commencing at the North East conner thereof and running seventy-five (75) feet west on the North side the same being the space in front of the Post-Office.

That this space be zoned for five minute parking and that the Town Marshal and Deputy Marshall be and they are hereby ordered to enforce this Ordinance to the effect that no automobiles be permitted to park longer than five minutes on this space.

Be it futher redolved that the State Highway Department is hereby requested to furnish the necessary signs to inform the public of this limited parking.


Dear Miss Kemp:
