

# Certificate of Town Corporation 1817

At a meeting of the citizens qualified voters of the Town of Corydon on Monday the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1817 in pursuance to an act entitled "an act for ordering for the incorporation of towns in the State of Indiana" Colonel Dipton was called to the Chair and R. W. Nelson Clerk, who being sworn agreeably to law the opinion of the qualified voters was then taken viva voce and were found to be as follows
